



## **GUIDELINES FOR NBIC GRADUATE RESEARCH AWARD**

The NBIC Graduate Research Award recognizes research accomplishments of graduate students in areas related to nanoscale science, the nano-bio interface, nanotechnology and/or interface control. Criteria for evaluating nominations include independent contribution to research, innovation in scientific approach, and potential impact of results. This competition is open to *all graduate level students across the University of Pennsylvania.*

The winner will be presented at the annual NanoDay@Penn event ([http://www.nanotech.upenn.edu/nano\\_day.html](http://www.nanotech.upenn.edu/nano_day.html)). This year, the date is October 23, 2013.

**AWARD:** \$200 cash prize, Certificate of Achievement, and delivery of a presentation preceding the NBIC Research Excellence Award.

**REQUIREMENTS:** All applications must be submitted electronically to [nbicasst@seas.upenn.edu](mailto:nbicasst@seas.upenn.edu) with the following items:

### **1. LETTER OF SUPPORT**

- A research faculty advisor must nominate the applicant.

### **2. RESEARCH SUMMARY**

- Applicant will submit a 2-page summary of research accomplishments making sure to identify research contributions and the significance of the work performed.
